Spelling	Learn this spelling rule: If the suffix follows a hard 'c' or 'g' it is 'ance' – elegance, significance, insignificance, arrogance, extravagance Words derived from verbs ending 'y' use the suffix 'ance' – defy and defiance – alliance, appliance, defiance, compliance, reliance Year 5/6 statutory words (to learn please): category committee communicate community competition		Learn this spelling rule: If the suffix follows a soft 'c' or 'g' or a 'qu' it is 'ence' Innocence, presence, intelligence, consequence Words with the syllables 'cid, fid, sid, vid' before the ending the suffix is 'ence' confidence, accidence, evidence		Learn this spelling rule: If the root word ends in 'e' it is often dropped before adding the suffix 'able' (adore/adorable) – believable, dividable, movable, arguable	
					If the root word ends in 'ce' or 'ge' the 'e' must be kept to prevent the 'c' or 'g' sounding hard – changeable, enforceable, chargeable, noticeable, manageable
