

**Vocabulary and Glossary**

Mammal	Animals that are warm blooded, breathe air and give birth to live babies.
Insect	A small animal whose body is divided into three parts. Insects also have three pairs of legs and usually one or two pairs of wings.
Reptile	Animals that breathe air, have dry, scaly skin and lay soft, leathery eggs
Egg	An egg is a round or oval object that contains what may become a young bird, reptile, insect, or other another animal.
Habitat	The natural environment of an animal or plant.
Environment	All the things together that surround animals and humans in the natural world.
Chrysalis	The hard outside covering on a moth or butterfly before it becomes an adult.
Antennae	Long, thin body parts on the head of insects and some other animals.
Ocean	A huge body of salt water.

**How are animals the same or different?**

Animals come in all shapes and sizes, and we can group them by how they are alike and how they are different.



All animals need food, water, and **a home** to live. Some animals **live in water**, and some live on **land**. Some have **fur**, some have **feathers**, and some have **scales**!

Ladybirds, butterflies and bumblebees are some of the **insects** that may be found in our school grounds. **Insects** have six legs, three body parts and **antennae**

### Which animals make the best pets?

Some animals make **good pets** because they can live happily in our homes.



Good pets are animals that **enjoy** being around **people** and don't need complicated care.
