<p>Children at the expected level of development will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function;• Share their creations, explaining the process they have used;• Make use of props and materials when role playing characters in narratives and stories <p>The skills and knowledge that allow children to achieve the Early Learning Goal are taught within focused tasks and the continuous provision throughout the Reception year.</p>

<p>Pupils should be taught:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• to use a range of materials creatively to design and make products• to use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination• to develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space• about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers, describing the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines, and making links to their own work.

<p>Pupils should be taught to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> develop their techniques, including their control and their use of materials, with creativity, experimentation and an increasing awareness of different kinds of art, craft and design. to create sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas to improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials [for example, pencil, charcoal, paint, clay] about great artists, architects and designers in history.
